Admissions

A new Application for Enrolment is required where a student leaves the College and subsequentlywishes to seek re-admission.

To be eligible for admission into the Early Learning Centre (ELC) at the beginning or during the school year, children must be three years of age by the end of January in the year of entry for ELC3. Entry directly into Prep following completion of ELC3 is not offered.

Under the State Government's <u>No Jab, No Play</u>Legislation, the College is unable to provide enrolment into the ELC unless the proposed student is fully vaccinated for their age, on a vaccination catchup program, or unable to be fully immunised for medical reasons.

6. Application Process

The proposed student will be added to the enrolment waiting list (s) requested (up to three different year levels of entry may be nominated) upon receipt of the Application for Enrolment or the International/Offshore Application Form; receipt of payment of the relevant application fee; and provision of required documentation specified in the application.

Following receipt of an Application for Enrolment, requests to add or change waitlisted year(s)/year level(s) can be made by contacting the College Admissions Office. The proposed stdent's application date for the additional waitlist will be recorded as the date the request is made.

Families seeking entry within six months (for commencement at the beginning of the following school year or part-way through a current school year) should contact the Admissions Office at entrolment@stleonards.vic.edu.auprior to submission of an Application for Enrolment.
